Purpose of the role:

Scope of responsibility:

- Responsible for providing statistical information and analysis to all parties involved with the management of the Consumer Lines profit centres. Constituencies include regional and corporate levels, general management, underwriting, marketing, actuarial and Regional finance.
- Ensure that all appropriate data is collected, coded and input into the system at the country level and those systems are available for data extraction and analysis.
- Responsible for production of all periodic and ad hoc reports for the management of all aspects of the consumer lines business.
- Supports the line managers with financial data and help with report creation/extraction.
- Manage the main financial and portfolio reporting to country Profit Centre management on Consumer Lines Profit & Loss performance
- Analyse and report on profitability by agent/product/rating factor and propose improvements to increase profitability
- Prepare budgets, quarterly estimates, monitor expense allocations to Profit Centres and resolve discrepancies/queries in relation to same.
- Work with underwriters to develop new products, schemes & pricing
- Monitor competitive marketplace.
- Build models to assist with the management of the portfolio.
- Assist in the development of underwriting philosophies based on analytical and actuarial analysis.

Accountabilities for the role:

- **Financial** - Contributions to fiscal performance of the company by establishing, managing and meeting GPW, NPW, STAT and GAAP targets for Consumer Lines. The results will be delivered through adherence to agreed decision making standards, limitations and authorities.
- **Strategic** - Provide leadership on all financial, expense, data, and portfolio management matters for the Profit Centres.
- **Operational** - Build, maintain, and enhance financial, data and portfolio management best practices and procedures. Work within the bounds of key regulatory and risk management responsibilities.
