Overall Purpose of Job/Role:

In order to support the continued development of Commercial Lines Insurance business we invite applications for the above position.

The primary function of the role is to undertake detailed Liability and Property risk management surveys and complete risk reports to support Underwriter decision making. Additionally the successful candidate will identify risk improvement requirements and recommendations for Underwriters and clients.

Key Duties / Responsibilities:

- Surveying medium to large Commercial Insurance new business propositions and renewals.
- Completing risk reports of detail appropriate to risk type and exposure.
- Providing guidance to Underwriters for calculating the maximum amount subject at any site.
- Identify and prioritise risk improvements.
- Negotiate effectively with clients and brokers on risk improvements and recommendations.

Key Skills and Competencies:

- The ideal candidate for this role needs to be a self-starter.
- Achieved a Professional Qualification in Health and Safety (Degree/Diploma).
- 1 – 3 years' experience carrying out liability and property risk assessments and accident investigation root cause analysis.
