- (1) The Motor Vehicle in respect of which this permit is issued may be kept or used by the grantee or by any person authorised by him who holds a Police Permit to drive a Motor Vehicle.
- (2) The Motor Vehicle in respect of which this permit is granted must not be kept elsewhere than at the address specified above.
- (3) This permit must always be carried on the vehicle in respect of which it is granted, and must be produced on demand to any Police Constable, or Soldier on duty.
- (4) In case of any change of ownership of the Motor Vehicle in respect of which this permit is issued, this permit must be surrendered to the issuing Officer.
- (5) If the Motor Vehicle in respect of which this permit is issued is kept or used otherwise than in accordance with the terms of this permit, and of any Order or Orders restricting the use of Motor Vehicles in Ireland, or in any part thereof, for the time being in force, the Motor Vehicle will be liable to be forfeited, and the holder of this permit will be liable in addition to the penalties provided in the Restoration of Order in Ireland Regulations.
