A completed Exemptions application form

Original or certified student full and final transcript with grades obtained (students must have passed the module)

Detailed syllabus of each / relevant module(s) on the transcript

Details of the structure of the qualification, distinguishing those units/modules that were compulsory from those that were optional

Assessment methods including details of pass mark and contribution to overall result from different methods of assessment, e.g. coursework and written examination (generally, at least 70% of the available marks should be contributed by written examination)

Copies of actual examination papers sat (or specimen examination papers)

### 2017 Fees

The exemption fee for each Insurance Institute programme from which exemption(s) are awarded is €75 (not applicable for CII, IOB or LIA exams).

However, please do not send payment with your application. If you are awarded any exemptions, you will receive written confirmation and be advised of the fees payable and the length of time for which the exemption offer is valid. Exemptions are only added to a student's record when any fees due are paid. Any offer of exemptions can be changed or withdrawn without notice if payment is not received.
